(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a baseball cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a baseball cap.

FIG. 2 is a right-side view of the baseball cap of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a left-side view of the baseball cap of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the baseball cap of FIG. 1, the only difference in this embodiment being that the cap does not include air-holes.

FIG. 5 is a right-side view of the baseball cap of FIG. 4.

FIG. 6 is a left-side view of the baseball cap of FIG. 4.

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of the baseball cap of FIG. 1, the only difference in this embodiment being that the cap does not include a button.

FIG. 8 is a right-side view of the baseball cap of FIG. 7.

FIG. 9 is a left-side view of the baseball cap of FIG. 7.

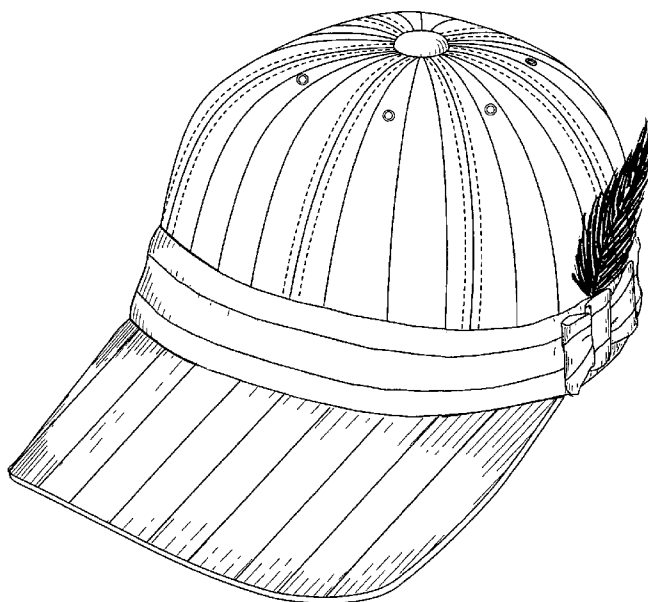
FIG. 10 is a perspective view of a fourth embodiment of the baseball cap of FIG. 1, the only difference in this embodiment being that the cap neither includes air-holes nor a button.

FIG. 11 is a right-side view of the baseball cap of FIG. 10; and,

FIG. 12 is a left-side view of the baseball cap of FIG. 10.

Stitching is drawn in dashed lines and does not form part of the claimed design.

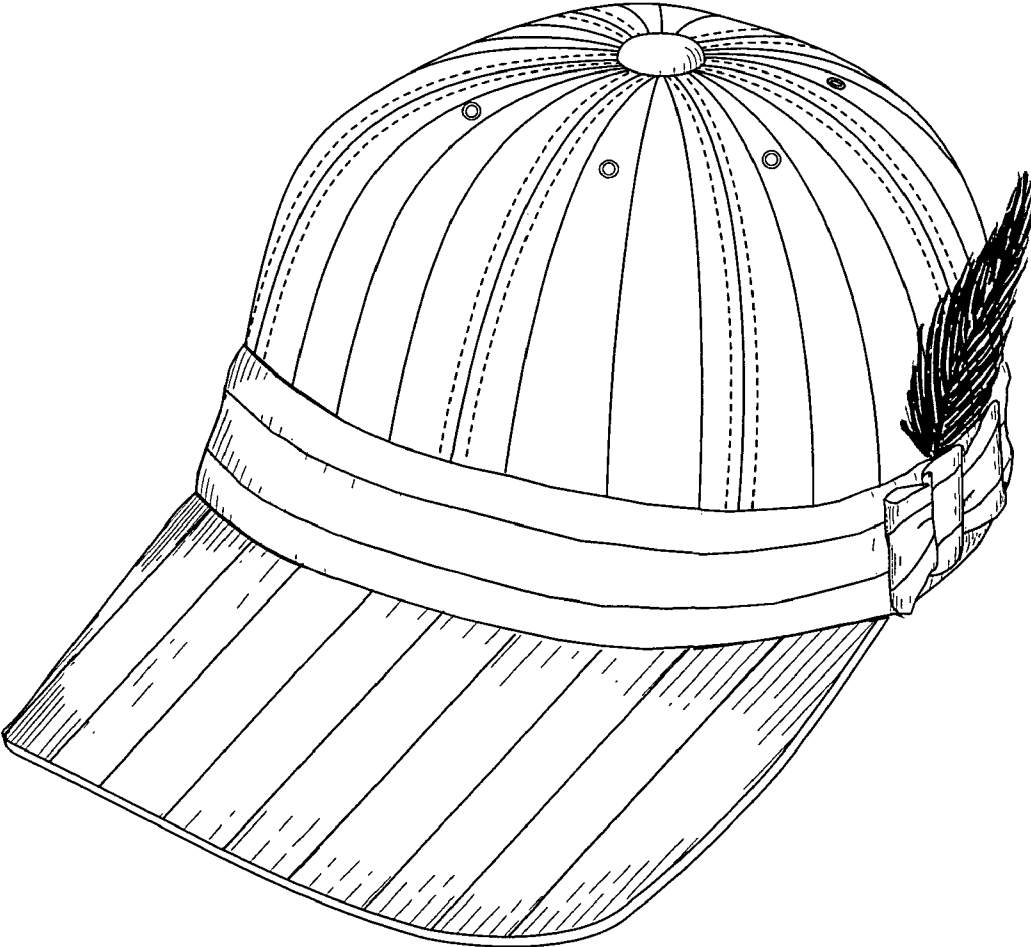

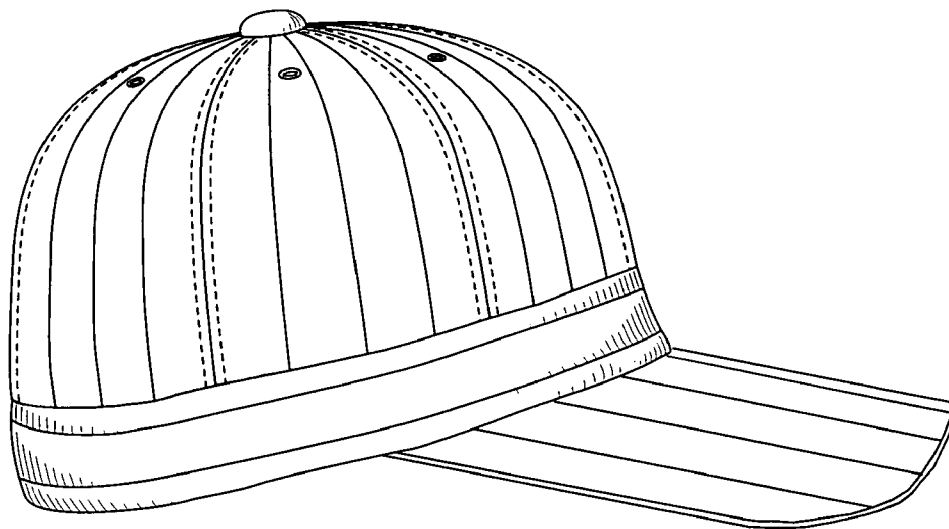

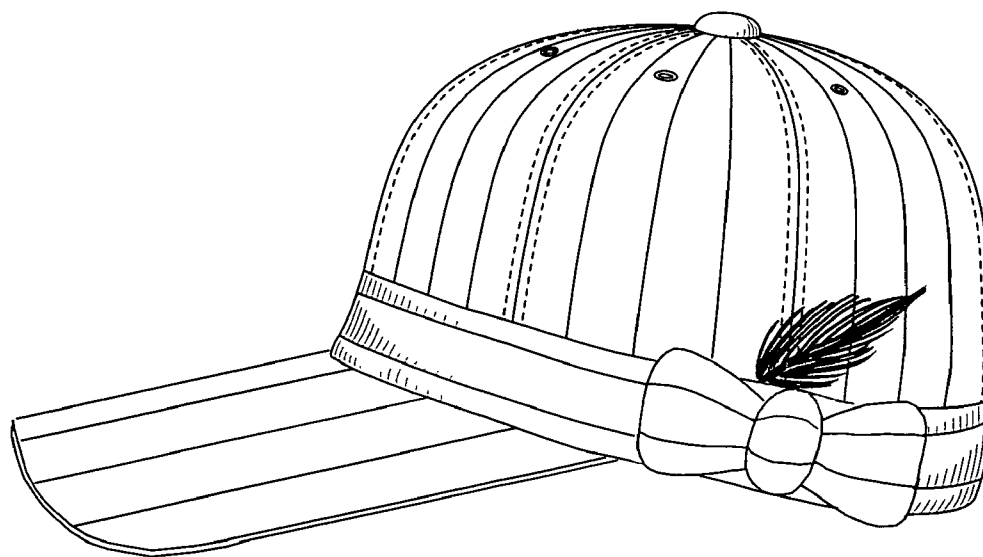

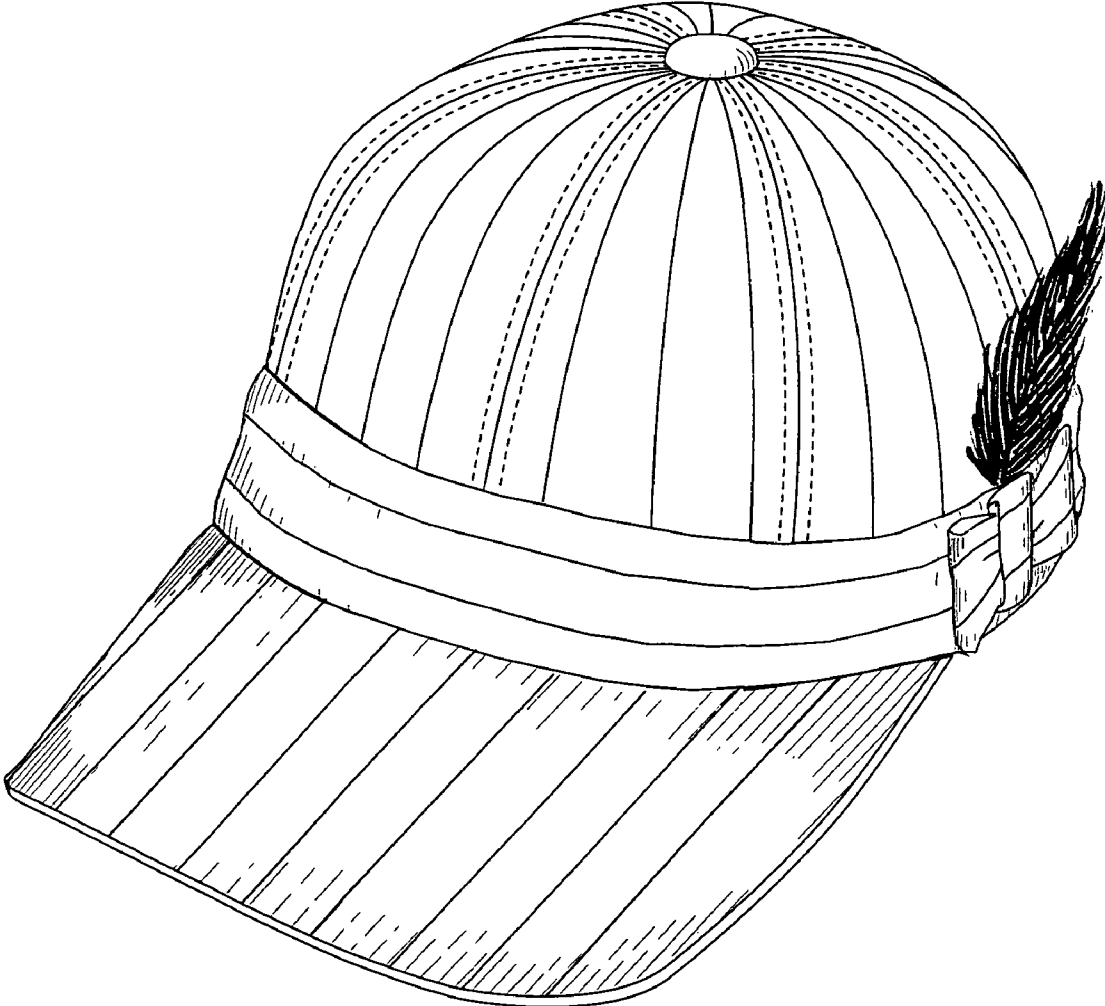

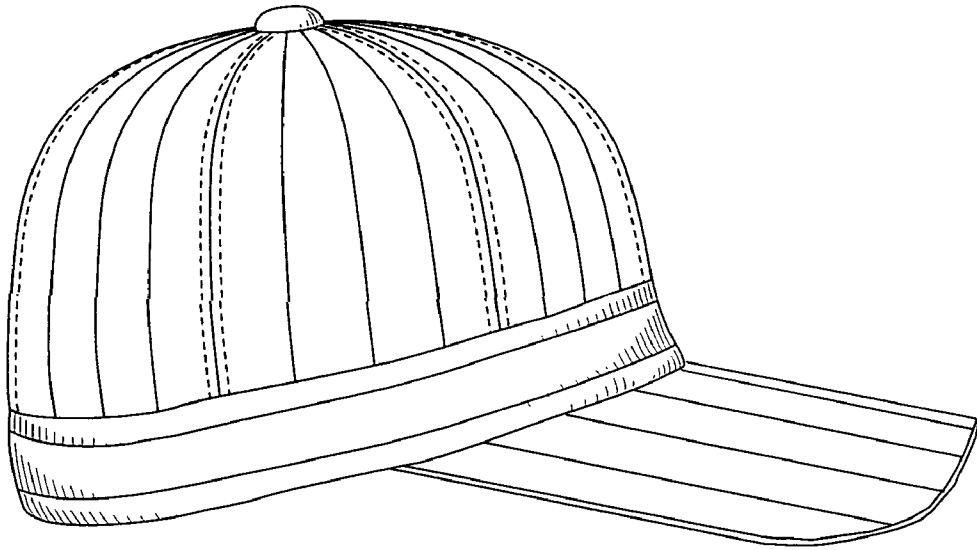

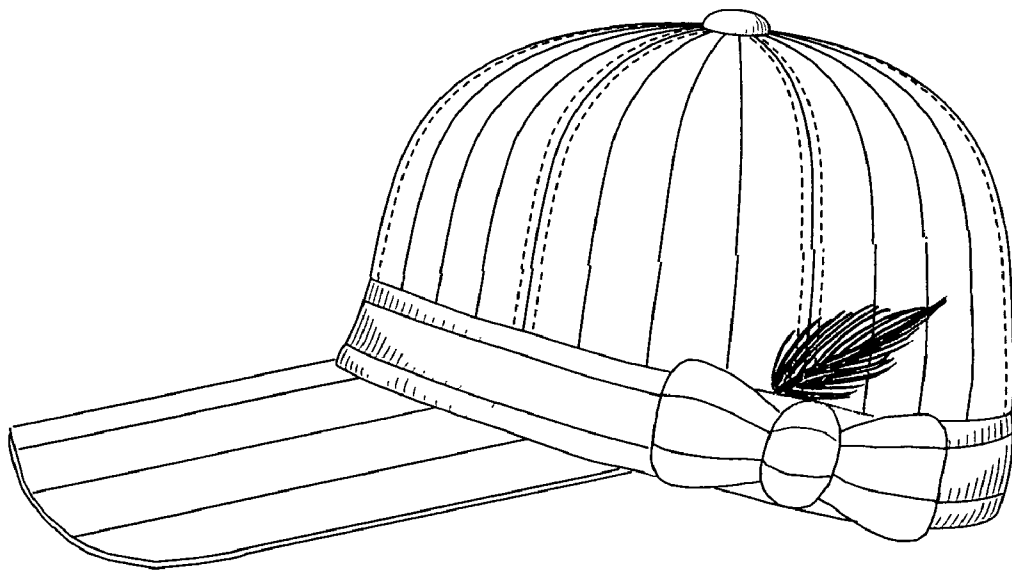

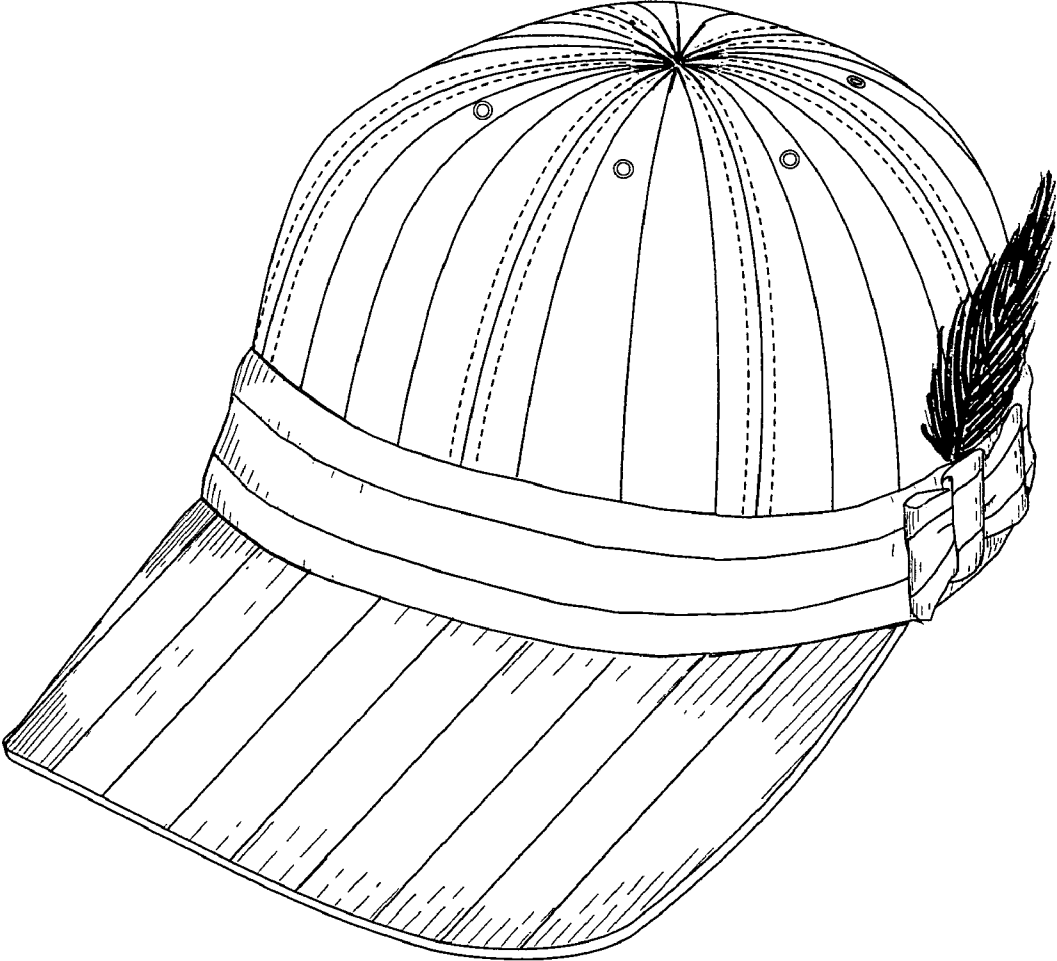

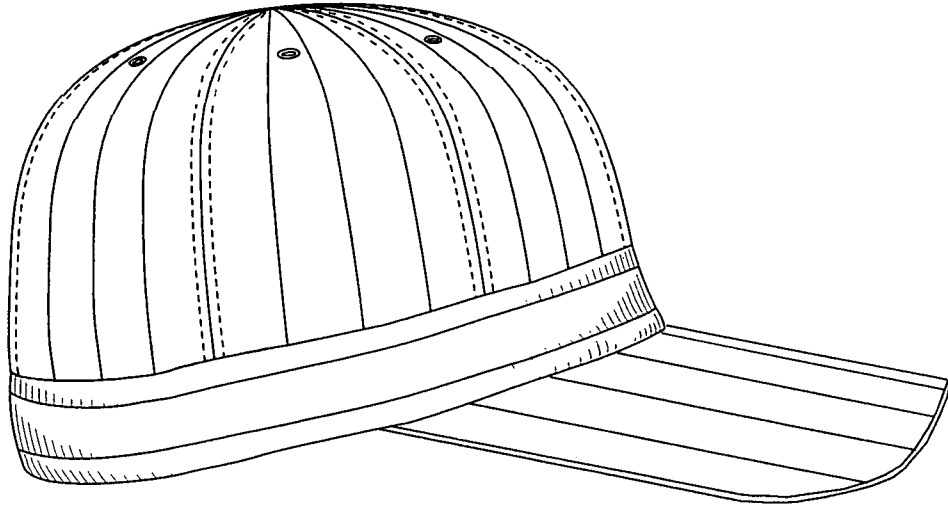

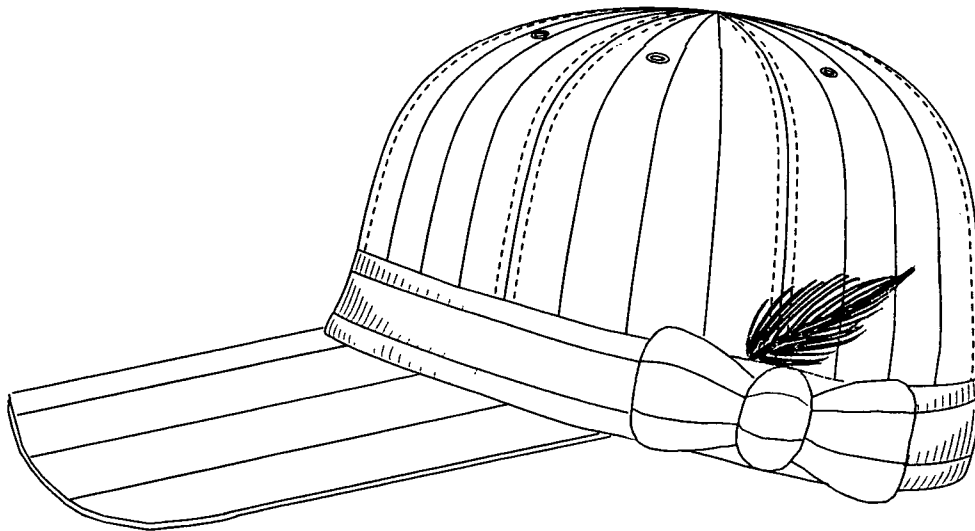

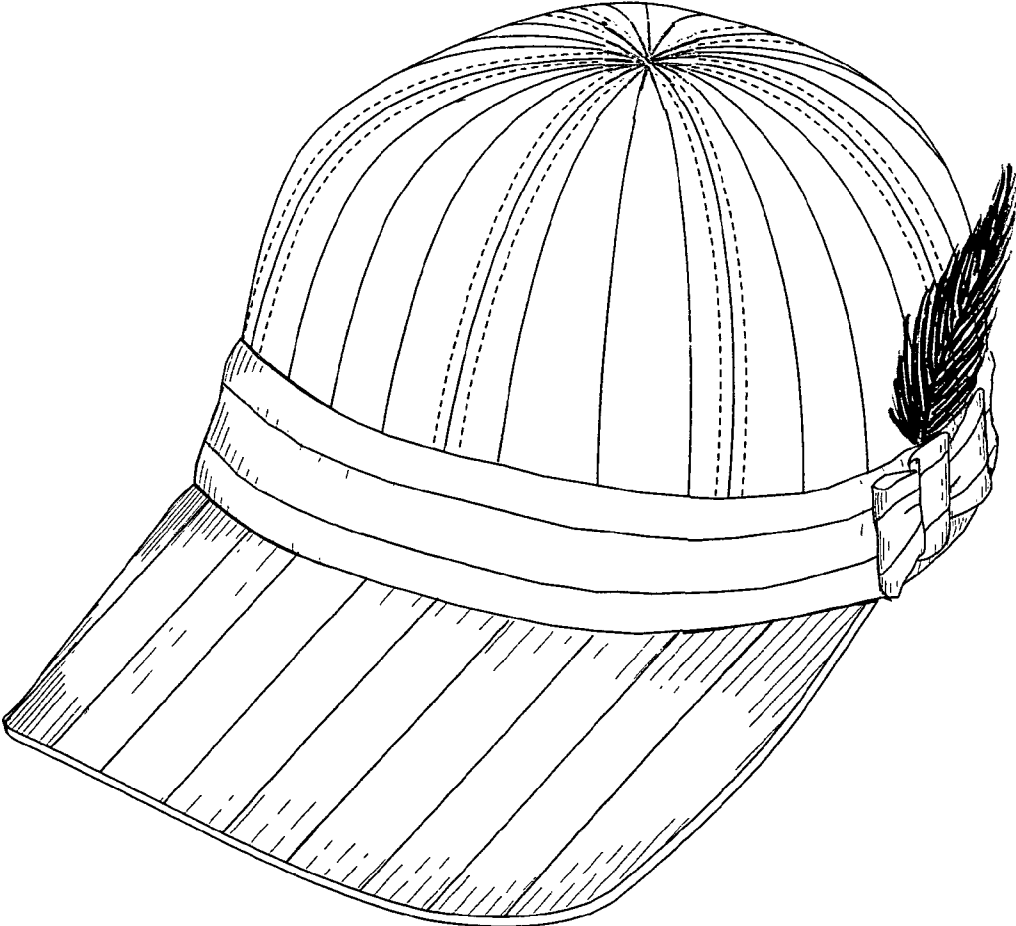

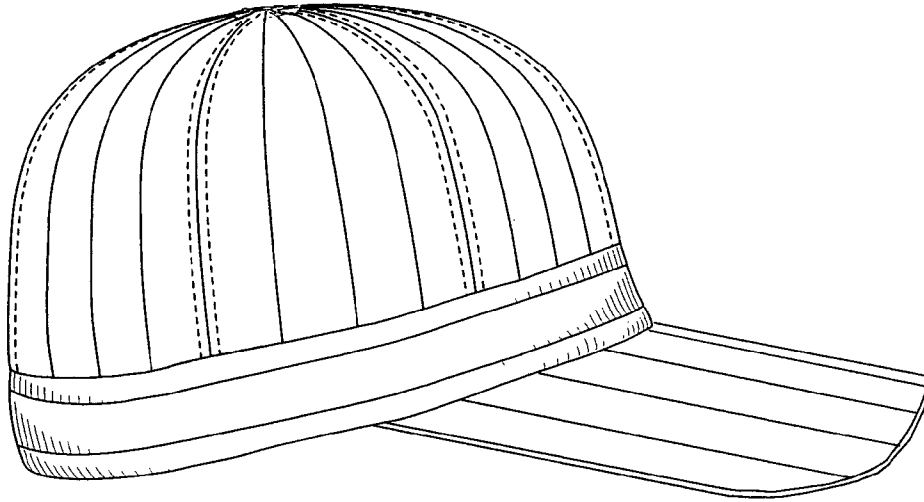

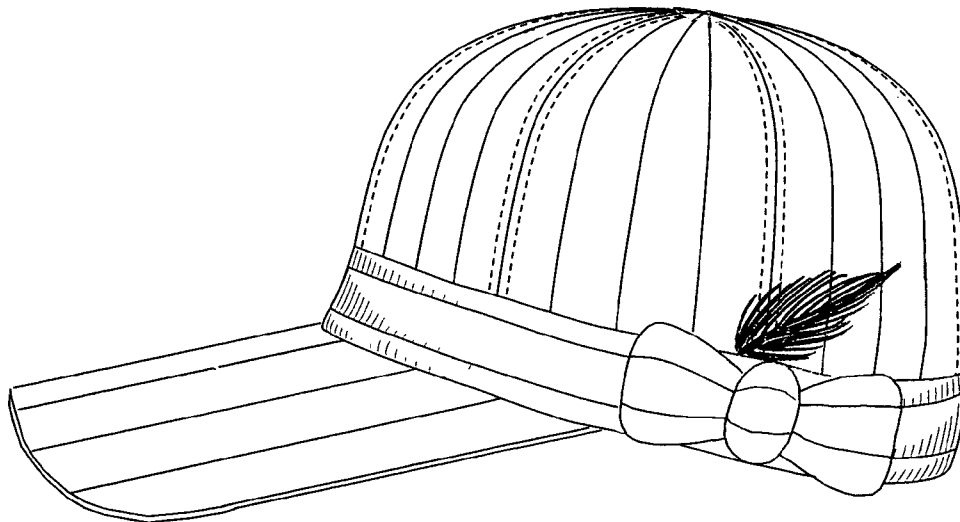
