(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a neonate medical wrap, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1. is a perspective view of a neonate medical wrap;  
FIG. 2. Is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 3. Is a rear view thereof;  
FIG. 4. Is a right-side view thereof;  
FIG. 5. Is a left-side view thereof;  
FIG. 6. Is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 7. Is a bottom view thereof; and,  
FIG. 8. Is a perspective view of the neonate medical wrap, shown in use.

The broken lines depict environment that forms no part of the claimed design.
